

ANNUAL EDUCATION RESULTS REPORT

Background

Accountability is the obligation to be answerable for the performance and results of one's assigned responsibilities. The Division recognizes its responsibility to keep school communities and partners informed about accomplishments and work toward goals.

The Division will keep its school communities and the public informed of the overall results achieved in the Division through publishing and distributing an Annual Education Results Report (AERR).

Definitions

Annual Education Results Report (AERR) - The AERR is an annual public report prepared by a school authority that summarizes performance results from the previous school year, including student achievement on local and provincial assessments, and results for other local and provincial assurance measures. It demonstrates accountability to the public and Alberta Education by showing progress towards education plan goals and identifying areas for improvement.

Education Plan – The Education Plan is the Division's multi-year strategic document that sets the direction for student learning and system improvement within the school division in alignment with the requirements established in the Education Act and the Alberta Education and Childcare Business Plan. The Education Plan sets goals and outcomes, performance measures and strategies that focus the Division's work.

Procedures

1. The Superintendent will develop an AERR in accordance with Alberta Education and Childcare policy. The Superintendent will submit a final document to the Board for approval. The Board will submit the Report to the Minister, in accordance with the regulations set forth by Alberta Education and Childcare.
2. The AERR will contain information regarding progress toward meeting the goals and objectives established by the Division in its Education Plan.
3. The AERR will contain the results on mandatory and optional measures gathered through the year from such activities as ongoing reviews, evaluations, surveys, planning sessions and workshops.
4. The format for reporting optional measures and additional information in the Division AERR will be determined by the Superintendent.

5. The AERR will be posted on the Division website.
6. The Division shall use the AERR for information in the planning and policy-making cycle and adjust its goals as necessary.
