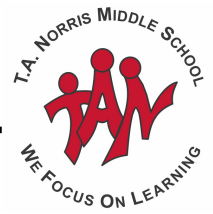

Best of luck to all students as you wrap up another successful school year!



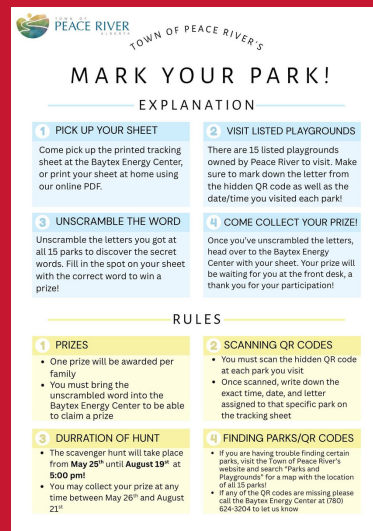

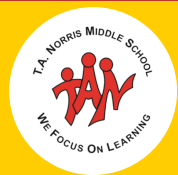
Ashley Hosfeld
